ADOPT-A-HORSE FOR THE MISSION FIELD

Camp Jabez is a missionary operation. That may sound unusual but nevertheless true. It is the goal of Camp Jabez to be an extension of the mission field of the inner city. As God has blessed us with a wonderful place, we need people who can appreciate God's wonderful creation and strive to use it to His honor and glory.

Camp Jabez is an outreach of the Gospel Mission, Inc. established in 1912. for the purpose of sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.



MANY THINGS ARE ACCOMPLISHED

The Adopt-A-Horse is designed to be a win-win situation for all concerned. This seven month program allows for very affordable training at excellent facilities and at the same time assists the camp in keeping the horses in good shape for the next camp season.

ADOPT-A-HORSE BENEFITS

There are so many benefits to this program that add up to a great value for a serious horse lover. We know of no place else where all of the following can be obtained for the price and accomplish all that it does.

- Full use of the Camp Jabez facility, trails, indoor arena (year around use)
- Trained staff on site.
- Use of our tack, no need to go out and buy saddles, bridles, halters, etc.
- Use of our "horse toys", barrels, cavelletis, etc.
- Includes two private lessons a month (private lessons normally are \$30 each).
- Includes the knowledge of being on a very safe and stable horse, you know the horse you are adopting (that is not always the case at rental or lease facilities).
- You are not responsible for vet or farrier needs (no extra hidden costs).

- Less expensive than leasing out at other barns where the cost of board alone can be over \$240 a month and most of those barns do not have year around riding facilities
- A new floor of washed sand in the barn (450 tons) has just been put down for a cleaner breathing atmosphere for those who may have allergies.
- In addition and very important, you are supporting a cause that goes way above and beyond riding a horse. You are assisting in helping other youth to have an experience with horses in the country that they normally would not have. You become part of the support team for a missionary organization.
