ANIMALS ARE GREAT BUT...

...horses do bite; kick and can unintentionally hurt you. Approach horses only with Camp Jabez staff. Do not put your hands or fingers through the bars in the stalls...your finger might look like a carrot.

There is a camp dog whose name is Patches. She is very friendly. Please be kind to her as well as the barn cats. Please do not feed any animals.

We ask that you do not bring your pets from home. Animals are very territorial and one of them could get hurt.

WATER SAFETY

Lake Jabez is a fun place when safety is first and foremost on everyone's mind.

No swimming or wading is allowed. Fishing must be done with caution concerning the fishhook. All fish are thrown back.

Paddle boating is great fun. For a safe operation, life jackets are required for all occupants. Please do not run boats aground or bump other boats. Load and unload only on rubber dock area. When finished, wipe out boat, cover and secure. No lifeguards are supplied. Please designate someone to watch the lake when children are with your group.

CAMP SAFETY

Whether you are here for just a day or an over-nighter, we want everything done to give you enjoyment. Please advise the camp staff if you will need a bonfire. We will get everything in order. All bonfires must be kept in designated areas. There is a fire extinguisher in the picnic shelter.

We recommend you bring first aid kits with you. We have emergency first aid kits in the barn foyer, barn side entrance always open, and in the Canteen. Please check to see if any of your campers have special needs concerning bee stings, etc.

We recommend that trail walks be in groups only. Do not venture off of trails. There are some deep ravines, which could bring injury. The woods and perimeter area contain poison ivy; please be careful. Maps are located in barn foyer and in the picnic shelter. Do not jump any fence lines.

Water from the well is safe to drink but it will contain a heavy mineral taste. Do not drink water from the run-off creek.

ACTIVE SPORTS

You are welcome to set up volleyball nets, soccer goals, play Frisbee, etc. Please take note of the terrain...there may be tree stumps, uneven ground, and mole holes. The southeast corner of the camp is a very big, flat, grassy field good for baseball, football, etc. This is located on the other side of the woods. See map.
